QUEENSLANDERS AT THE GREAT LAKES RALLY

A number of Queenslanders made the trip down to Forster on the NSW Central Coast for the running of the Great Lakes Rally which was the fifth round of the Australian Rally Championship.

This year was the first time that the NSW Round of the ARC had been based in this area. The roads were very good. The local Council appeared to be very supportive of the event, and the Service Park on the beachfront at Forster was a fantastic location. However the organization of the event was not up to the usual high standard of other ARC rounds. It was very surprising to go to Scrutineering and find that there were only two Scrutineers. There were mistakes in the Road Book

(corrected in a Bulletin that was issued after Reconnaissance). The fuel was delivered to the wrong place and competitors were advised that it was their responsibility to move their fuel to the Refuel Zone. In fact the whole issue of Control Fuel was a joke as there were many opportunities that competitors could easily have swapped fuel drums. Similarly for tyre use as there no tyre marking at all during the event. Hopefully the organizers are aware of the shortcomings of the event (Many others as well as those mentioned here) and will be looking at ways that things can be improved for next year.

Most of the Queenslanders had a good run in Heat 1 on the Saturday apart from John Goasdoue and Andrew Crossley who went a bit wide on a tricky left hander and put the Lancer over a fairly steep bank. The car was too badly damaged to be able to restart on the Sunday.

Chris Murphy was navigating for Eli Evans from Victoria and they achieved a very good second place in Heat 1. The next best Queenslanders were Bruce Fullerton and Hugh Reardon - Smith who were in 14th place. Tony Best navigating for Derek Reddie from WA was in 18th place and Scott Beckwith navigating for John Berne from Sydney was in 20th place. Mark Stacey navigating for Michael Guest in the Pirtek Ford Team produced some good stage times but exceeded their Late Time Limit due to a mechanical problem on a liaison stage.

The scores for the top ten placegetters in Heat 1 were extremely close. This was partly due to the fact that most competitors completed only four stages. The fifth stage was a short run at the Taree Show Grounds. For some unknown reason the ARC and Classics arrived there about the same time. Most of the ARC Crews waited while the Classic went round the stage. They were eventually told to go back to Forster as the stage had been cancelled for them. They may as well have stayed at Taree as after a long wait at Forster they were told that the remaining stages for the day would be cancelled due to the fact that the radio communications were not working on these stages, Maybe they need Fred van Tuinen to help them next year.

There was a large crowd at Taree who were presumably fairly disappointed. The small retirement rate on the Saturday was also probably due to the small distance travelled. Even after the Two Hour Service at the end of the day most cars were in the overnight Parc Ferme by 4pm.

Fortunately the problems were fixed and all stages were run on the Sunday. There was nearly an hour delay at the start of the second stage. Rumour has it that the Flying Finish and Stop were set up ready and Triple Zero shifted them to a different location a couple of kilometres down the road. Then Double Zero came along and shifted them back to the original location.

The Taree Showgrounds Stage was run on the Sunday. It was very dusty and there was a noticeably smaller crowd.

There were a lot of retirements on the Sunday compared with the Saturday. Michael Guest and Mark Stacey were able to finish the second heat in third place outright. Bruce Fullerton and Hugh Reardon - Smith finished tenth outright and this was enough to give them first place in the Challenge Category. They are now equal leaders in the Challenge with one round to go.

John Berne and Scott Beckwith finished in 13th place after a trouble-free run while Derek Reddie and Tony Best finished 17th. They had a puncture early on a stage and with 15 km to go they had to stop to change the wheel. However they still managed to win the P 6 Class. They are now leading this class in the ARC but Mitchell Hall from SA is still only a few points behind.
